

Free online programs to help with school and homework (for high school students)

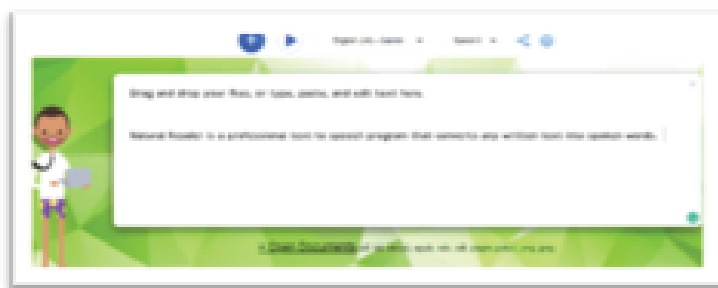

Help with READING and EDITING

- NaturalReader Online is a text-to-speech program that converts text into natural sounding speech.
- Can read MS Word, Pages, PDF files, PowerPoint, webpages and non-DRM eBooks. Unlimited usage with a range of voices or 20 minutes a day with some of their very special voices!
- Sit back and let your computer read to you! This is a great tool to help with editing your written work



Rewordify

- Paste in text and Rewordify simplifies difficult English, greatly aiding reading.
- Helps to teach you new words and extend your vocabulary.
- Hover over text for definitions and to hear word read aloud.
- Can choose reading level and how text is displayed

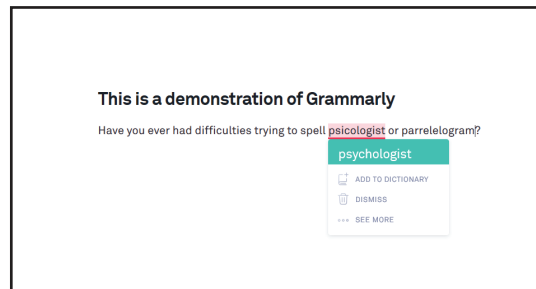

Grammarly

www.grammarly.com

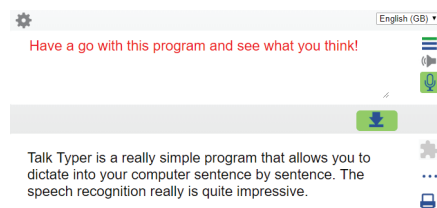
- Paste in text and use Grammarly as an online proof reader
- Grammarly finds possible mistakes in spelling and grammar and suggests corrections.
- More advanced than proof readers included in word processing programs like Word and Pages.
- Text can also be highlighted and read out



Talk Typer

- Want help getting your ideas from your head onto the screen? Simple to use online dictation tool – just speak into microphone on your device
- Word or sentences appear in a basic word processor which can be edited with a keyboard
- Edited text can be printed, emailed, copied or pasted
- Needs to be used in Google Chrome

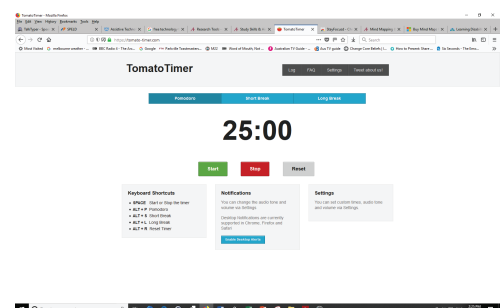


Help with KEEPING FOCUSED

- Set the timer to 25 minutes of work and then have a short (5 mins) or longer break

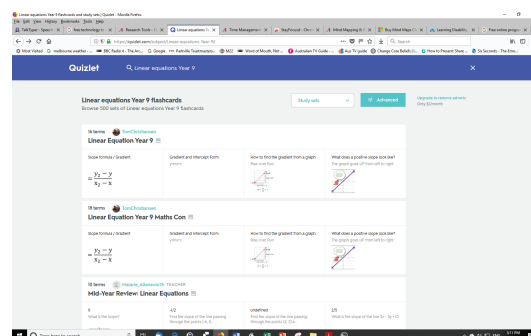


Help with REVISING
